PLEASE NOTE: Any changes to the event details on page 1 (tickets prices, dates, discounts, etc.) must be approved in writing prior to the event. Failure to secure approval will result in revocation of the Waiver. An organization may only apply for a Community Benefit Fund Rent Waiver Grant once in each calendar year, for a maximum four-day run. Daily facility rental fee not to exceed \$4,000 per day. Organization is responsible for all other charges incurred with the facility. Applications will be reviewed by the Cultural Arts Council.
